Do you have a legal problem?

In honor of Elizabeth Peratrovich, volunteer lawyers will be available to assist AFN convention attendees with civil legal issues involving family law (like child custody matters, divorce questions, and foster care licensing), difficulties with receiving public benefits, safe housing, consumer issues and completing your estate planning with a Will.



WHEN

General civil legal issues will receive assistance on Thursday, October 20 between 1 and 4pm. Assistance with writing a Will and other estate planning will occur on Friday, October 21 between 8 and 11am.

HOW

- What best describes your legal issue? Pick one: Family law, housing, consumer, public benefits, writing a Will, or other. If you choose other, please describe BRIEFLY.
- Preferred day and time for appointment.
- Whether you have a need for a language interpreter and what language. We will try to accommodate as much as possible.
